9th Grade Art

Introduction to 9th Grade Art.

AIMS:

1. Students will be familiarized with the rituals and routines of the classroom.
2. Students will create a one point perspective drawing.

GRADE LEVEL: 9th grade art class, meeting 3 times per week: for 1-40 minute period on Monday, and 2-80 minute periods held either on Tuesday/Thursday or Wednesday/Friday.

MATERIALS: Notebooks, Sketchbooks, pencils, attendance material, Escher slides, computer and projector.

DO NOW:

1. Students will complete *Delaney Cards*, or other attendance taking materials with special emphasis on parents' home and cell numbers.

PROCEDURE:

1. Teacher will introduce the topic of One Point Perspective.
 - Show Escher Slides, Otro Mundo 1 & 2
 - Who among you can identify this artist?
 - How were these works created? What did materials did the artist use?
 - What techniques did the artist use?
 - What moves you about these pictures?
2. Teacher will demonstrate how to access <http://arts.professorklein.com> and the *Moodle portal*.
3. Teacher will direct students to the *Basic Perspective Handout* and *Ways of Holding a Pencil*.
4. Teacher will demonstrate how to draw using one point perspective.
5. Students will begin the assignment: One Point Perspective Drawing of a Hallway.

HOMEWORK: Students will read *Basic Perspective Handout* and *Ways of Holding a Pencil*. They will finish their One Point Perspective Drawing of a Hallway. (Line & Contour)
